Do in remembrance of me.

1 Cor 11:23 For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, That the Lord Jesus the same night in which he was betrayed took bread:

24. And when he had given thanks, he brake it, and said, Take, eat: this is My body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of Me.

{1} Keeping Jesus on our mind and in our hearts, will keep us doing what He told us to do.

{2} Gather all the things you know about Jesus in you mind and in your heart and let them come out of your mouth.

{3} Make your self some notes, write what you know about Jesus on some paper and keep on writting them until it becomes written in your hearts, then you will never forget Jesus and what He has done for you.

{4} When Joshua had crossed the Jordan, before the waters came back together, God told Joshua to send one man from each Tribe, and brng out a stone, build and altar. When your children look at these stones and ask what they mean, You can tell them of what God has done for you. Tell it again and again....

2009 can be the year you lead some body to Jesus.

{1} So remind me dear Lord.

2 Peter 3:1. This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in both which I stir up your pure minds by way of remembrance:

2. That ye may be mindful of the words which were spoken before by the holy prophets, and of the commandment of us the apostles of the Lord and Saviour:

{a} This word "mindful" is a powerful word from God....NT:3403
to remind, i.e. (middle voice) to recall to mind: be mindful, remember.

Heb 2:1. Therefore we ought to give the more earnest heed to the things which we have heard, lest at any time we should let them slip.

Heb 2:1. We must pay more careful attention, therefore, to what we have

heard, so that we do not drift away. NIV

{1} This New Year most of us don't need a new vision> We just need to let the blood of Jesus wash off the vision we once had, and get on with letting it become fruitful.....

Deut 2:3. Ye have compassed this mountain long enough: turn you northward.

Num 9:21 Sometimes the cloud stayed only from evening till morning, and when it lifted in the morning, they set out. Whether by day or by night, whenever the cloud lifted, they set out.

22. Whether the cloud stayed over the tabernacle for two days or a month or a year, the Israelites would remain in camp and not set out; but when it lifted, they would set out.

23. At the LORD's command they encamped, and at the LORD's command they set out. They obeyed the LORD's order, in accordance with his command through Moses.

{1} This must remember: Jesus was born: Jesus became in the flesh and lived among me: Jesus died and came out of the tomb and went back to Heaven and sent us the Holy Ghost with Power, told us to preach the Gospel, lay hands on the sick, cast out devils, and speak with new tongues.

1 Cor 11:23. For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, That the Lord Jesus the same night in which he was betrayed took bread:

24. And when he had given thanks, he brake it, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me.

25. After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me.

26. For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do shew the Lord's death till he come.

27. Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink this cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord.

28. But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup.

29.For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body.

30.For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.

20.Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, *This cup is the new testament in my blood, which is shed for you.*
