John 11:

{a} Right in the middle of the story of Lazarus, Jesus was talking to Martha,

Martha tells Jesus, "If you would have been here, Lazarus would have never died:" She goes on however and says in verse 22 " But I know, that even now, {been dead four days by this time he stinketh} thou wilt ask of God, God will give thee.

John 11:25. Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:

26. And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this? Trust--no doubt--what I believe and how much I believe it.

27. She saith unto him, Yea, Lord: I believe that thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world.
