## **GENERATION**

**So it is best to avoid forcing our English understanding of generation (the average period of time between the birth of a parent and the birth of his firstborn child, about 25-30 years) upon the word as it is used in the Bible.**

**When you study the Genealogy of Jesus {family tree} In the Book of Matt.1: 2-16, you find some 41 names of His blood line. Starting with Abraham on down to Jesus:**
