{3} In the book of Matt. 26:26-30 we find Jesus and the decipiles eating supper, Dr. Luke calls the supper, the Passover

[hah LELL] (praise thou the Lord)-a song of praise celebrating God's mighty acts on behalf of His Chosen People, the nation of Israel. The complete text of the song is contained in Ps 115-118. The Hallel was sung in Jewish homes at the PASSOVER meal and at other major FEASTS AND FESTIVALS during the Hebrew year.

{2} From Psa.`115--118 is the Hymn that was either sung or chanted.

Look at Ps 118:24.This is the day which the LORD hath made; we will rejoice and be glad in it. KJV

{3} When Jesus used the term " **This cup**" Matt 26:39.And he went a little further, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, **O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt.**

Matt 26:42.He went away again the second time, and prayed, saying, **O my Father, if this cup may not pass away from me, except I drink it, thy will be done.KJV**

{1} Cup in these verses mean "fate or reason"
